- **Human Service Providers**  
Develops and implements strategies to increase human service providers' awareness of domestic violence.
- **Law Enforcement/Judicial**  
Identifies gaps and develops and implements strategies to provide a coordinated community response to domestic violence through the law enforcement and judicial systems.
- **Legislative**  
Monitors and evaluates domestic violence legislation.
- **Health Care**  
Develops and implements strategies to increase health care providers' awareness of domestic violence.
