YWCA York continues to monitor the rapidly evolving impact of the COVID-19 virus on our operations. Our mission in the community remains strong during these challenging times and we are most grateful for the support and understanding of our members, families, clients, donors and staff.

This memo is to inform our YWCA Family of our decisions regarding operations starting effective Tuesday, March 17, 2020.

In keeping with the directive of Governor Tom Wolf, YWCA York is shutting down all programs and services offered at our main location at 320 E. Market Street through Saturday, March 28th.

Services provided to victims of violence through our shelters will continue. Domestic violence and sexual assault hotlines operated by YWCA York will be staffed 24/7. Legal advocacy will continue as long as the York County Judicial Center remains open. Medical Advocates will provide hospital response by telephone and not report in person to our health care partners.
